**PUBLIC HEARINGS**

What to expect when you speak – your rights & responsibilities:	
♦ To speak to the item without time constraints	
♦ Provide evidence where possible – and stay focused	
♦ Sign up sheet may be available just prior to hearing	
How to submit written comments in advance of the hearing:	
♦ Must be submitted prior to the close of the hearing	
♦ If you aren't attending the hearing submit your letter	
▫ with the item description and/or number included	
▫ indicating the letter is "for the record"	
▫ addressed to the voting body – or its chair	
▫ in advance of 5 PM on the day of the hearing	
▫ to the city department head, if a commission. Note that email is usually accepted, but a signed letter with copies for each commissioner may be requested

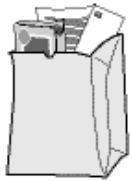

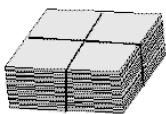

LAND USE COMMISSIONS IN NORWALK

The following commissions are made up of appointed citizens who serve without pay. Commission meetings take place at least once monthly. Meetings are open to the public to observe. The public have an opportunity to speak at public hearings that are scheduled through these commissions.

◆ Planning Commission

This City Board reviews subdivisions and other land use matters. It is also responsible for the update of the Plan of Conservation and Development every ten years.

◆ Zoning Commission

This commission reviews and approves site plans. It also makes decisions on zoning amendments and zoning regulation changes, and acts as the city's Aquifer Protection Agency.

◆ Zoning Board of Appeals

The ZBA makes decisions on requests for variances and on appeals of zoning violation orders and appeals of 'cease and desist' orders.

◆ Conservation/Inland Wetlands Commission

As the Conservation Commission this board also acts as the Inland Wetlands Agency. As such it is responsible for seeing that our valuable wetlands are protected.

### Plan of Conservation & Development ...a.k.a. the Master Plan

The Master Plan for Norwalk has recently been updated. It is the blueprint for development and a vision for directing Norwalk's future development.

State Statues require municipalities to adopt an updated Plan of Conservation & Development every ten years. The Planning Commission has the responsibility for this task – with input from the public.

Excerpt from the Code of the City of Norwalk

*"Norwalk became a city in 1913, at which time it consolidated with South Norwalk and the East Norwalk Fire District. While only a few simple laws were necessary in 1913, the complexity of modern life has created the need for detailed laws or ordinances for the government of a city. The collection of law is an aspect of municipal history and as the orderly development of the community progresses this collection must keep pace. Modernization and orderly development apply to all phases of local affairs and most particularly to the ordinances and laws which govern."*

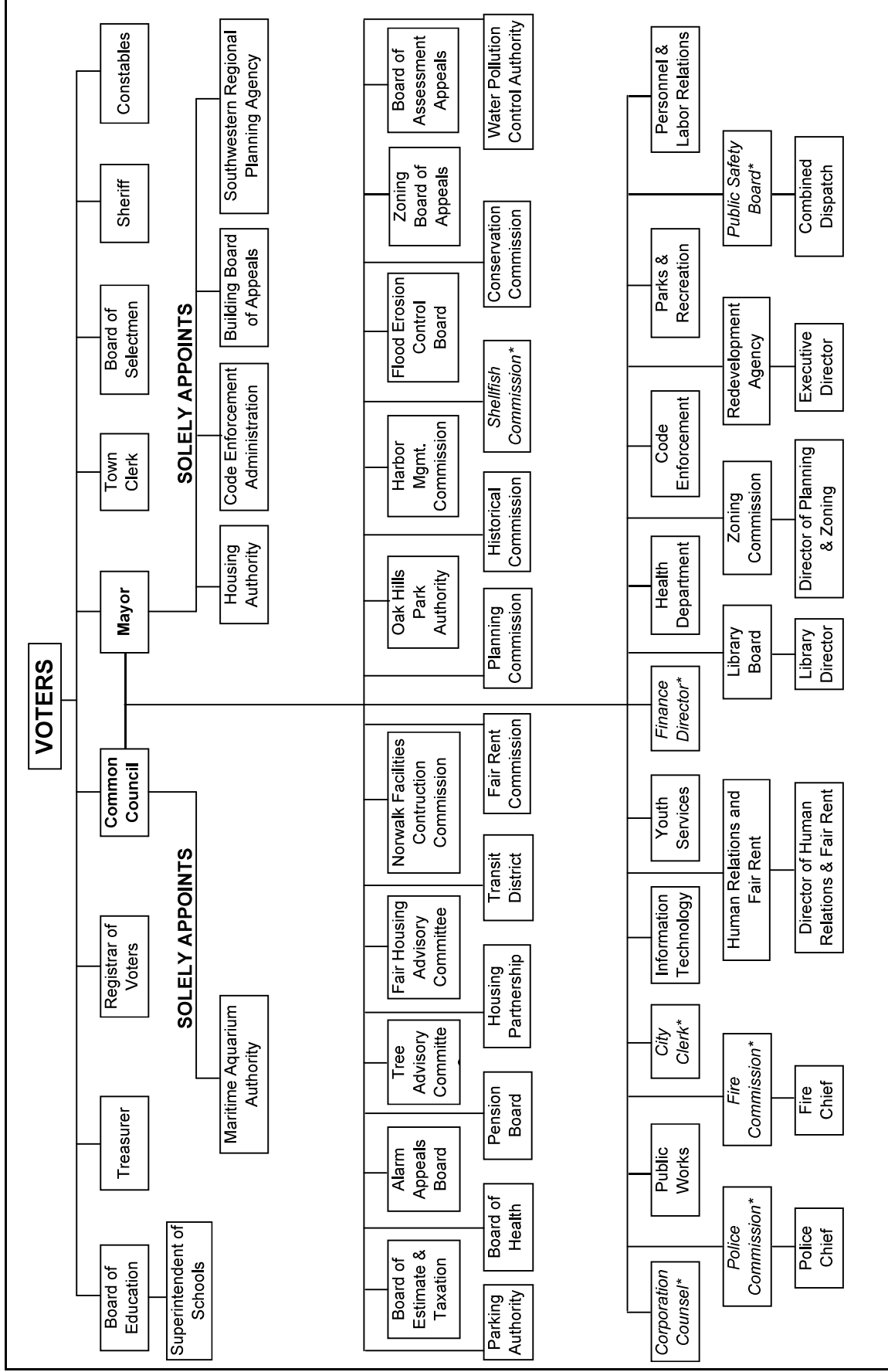
